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Dear Parent/Carer,

On **Tuesday 30th June 2026**, your young person will be participating in the Holocaust 360 event, an immersive educational experience designed to deepen their understanding of the Holocaust and the experiences of those affected by it.

Using innovative technology and powerful historical testimony, Holocaust 360 allows students to engage with this important period of history in a meaningful and memorable way. The experience supports our study of the Holocaust and encourages students to reflect on the consequences of prejudice, discrimination and intolerance. This will take place in school.

To allow all students to participate, the day will be divided into two sessions:

Session 1: Periods 2 and 3

Session 2: Periods 4 and 5

Students will be assigned to one of these sessions and will be informed of their allocated session and room in advance. **Please ensure that your child arrives at school as normal and attends registration and Period 1 as usual.**

To ensure the event runs smoothly, students should:

- Wear full school uniform.
- Arrive promptly at their allocated session.
- Bring any equipment requested by their teacher.
- Listen carefully to instructions from staff and presenters.
- Show respect at all times, both to the content being studied and to other participants.
- Engage thoughtfully with the activities and discussions.

The Holocaust is a sensitive and important topic. Some of the material may be challenging, but it has been carefully designed for educational purposes and provides an important opportunity to learn about a significant event in world history. I will be with the students throughout the day to support them, answer any questions they may have and facilitate any follow-up conversations where needed.

Please note that students who miss a Year 9 examination due to their participation in Holocaust 360 will sit the assessment on Wednesday 1st July.
