Dear Parent/Carer,

Photography Trip: London Viewpoints - Friday 3rd July 2026

As part of a student's photography GCSE they need to complete several coursework projects which count for 60% of the overall GCSE. For them to get as much out of the projects as possible, students would benefit from visiting more than one point of interest in order to fulfil their briefs and complete a variety of photoshoots. This will be a walking photography tour of London.

We will start our tour in Shoreditch, walking through Brick Lane and on to the city. We will then make our way towards London Bridge and over the river to Borough Market, where there will be more opportunities for photoshoots. After lunch we will continue our journey along Southbank, towards the old power station, also known as the Tate Modern. This trip is a fantastic opportunity and will be a great experience for all students, having a whole day dedicated to their photography.

The cost of the trip will be £12.80. You can pay via Arbor. This covers all travel costs and insurance. There is a shop at the Tate Modern and an array of food stalls at Borough Market, if they wish to bring any money.

We will be travelling to London by train, so I would ask that you get your young person to Harlow Town train station no later than 9.10am. We will be arriving back into Harlow Town train station at 3.49pm, so please can you make arrangements for their return home from the station.

Students are expected to wear **suitable** casual clothes and **sensible walking shoes or trainers**, as there will be a lot of walking. Please advise them to bring a waterproof jacket if it is forecast to rain, and/or sun cream if it is forecast to be hot. They should also bring a notebook, pen and a packed lunch.
