







The basic expectation can be summed up as "not seen, not heard, not taken".


Between the hours of 08:00 and 15:30, personal electronic devices will always be switched off and kept out of sight on the school premises*.

Sanctions


- In the **first** instance - device is confiscated, 30-minute same day detention. Devices will be given back after detention
- In the **second** instance - device is confiscated, 60-minute same day detention. Devices will be given back after detention
- If there is a **third** instance - device is confiscated, 60-minute same day detention. Parent/Carer will need to collect device
- Repeat offenders will not be permitted to bring devices on to site
- Refusal to handover devices will result in an escalated sanction






