

When students are in year 11, they are placed in a tutor group with their own year group; this enables them the time and space to prepare for examinations and post-16.

Each tutor group belongs to one of four houses, which are led by a Head of House. Attitude, hard work and excellence are rewarded with points. This encourages healthy competition and our students to strive in every area of school life.
