Re: Photography Component 1 & Component 2, Deadlines and Booster Sessions

I am writing to you to let you know that your young person is almost at the end of their Component 2 work in Photography. This is the Externally Set Assessment (ESA). Students have been given a checklist to follow with tasks for each week to help them to plan their work and evidence the four assessment objectives. The project will finish with a 10-hour controlled assessment over two days.
